

## PAINTING ROLLS

**Assorted brushes.**

**Colours:**

**White**

**Yellow Ochre**

**Burnt Sienna**

**Burnt Umber**

**Stone shape:**

**Round / oval convex rocks.**



Nicely rounded rocks like these are mostly grey in colour. Paint a basecoat of white before you begin.



First, mix White with a little Yellow Ochre. Then add a little Burnt Sienna to the mixture. Paint the rock with this colour leaving some 'cracks' of white to show.



Using a worn out brush, dap Burnt Sienna on the bread as shown here.



Dilute the Burnt Sienna to draw an outline on the 'cracks'.



Next, use Burnt Umber to dap all over the bread.

## PAINTING ROLLS



Including the 'cracks' of the bread.



Using a liner brush, outline the 'cracks' with Burnt Umber. Create little fine lines in the 'cracks' as well.



Draw White highlights next to the Burnt Umber lines painted earlier.



Complete your bread by using White to dap all over the bread to resemble fine sugar or you can omit this step.



Your rolls are done.
